- Introduction to Unions and Guilds, the Structure of the U.S. Market
- Stunt Training: Action Scene Approach and Simple Stunt Choreography

Outdoor Classroom:

- Visit to one of Hollywood's world-renowned studios, such as Warner Bros., Sony Entertainment, Paramount, or Universal Studios
- 2 Units of Stunt Training (as described above)
- Cultural City Tour
- Trip to a Networking Event for Filmmakers and Actors

Creative Project: Participants will develop a scene, which will be filmed and analyzed.

Certificate: After successful completion of the course, participants will be awarded the Steinlein Productions Certificate of Achievement.

Extras: Flights, Airport Pick-Ups and Drop-Offs, Meals, Housing Placement Services, Accommodations, Inner-City Transportation, and individual Sightseeing Excursions are <u>not</u> included in tuition fee.

Photo Session: Upon request, a photo session can be arranged with a Hollywood photographer. Packages start at U.S. \$650 (Euro 450) and include the services of a makeup artist.

Private Coaching: In addition to the existing curriculum, private coaching sessions can be arranged for \$150 (Euro 125).

Accommodations: Upon request, Steinlein Productions will arrange accommodations placement for you. Students who stay for four weeks can rent out a room with an American host family. Students staying for two weeks can either be placed with an American host family (depending on availability) or at a local youth hostel.

Meals: There are several cafés and restaurants near the Institute, which offer American, Californian, Mexican, Asian, and Indian cuisine.

Transportation: The Metro and a bus stop are conveniently located next to the school.
